Position Details

- Voluntary position with support from Volleyball Australia Staff
- Age Group Head Coach role would begin February 2022
- Age Group Head Coach role would conclude once preparations for the FIVB Age Group World Championships are completed. I.e., if team fails to qualify for FIVB World Championships, the Age Group Head Coach role would conclude.

Expectations

- Regularly communicate with Volleyball Australia's National Pathways Manager, High Performance
 Operations Manager, High-Performance Program Coordinator
- Attend all Volleyball Australia Junior Development Program Camps and Tours applicable to appointed age group.
- Attend nominated state-based Junior Development Program camps within appointed term
- Liaise with Australian Volleyball Academy (AVA) Coaches regarding technical direction of age group.
- Commit to ongoing Coach Education via the Volleyball Australia Coach Accreditation Program



Responsibilities

- Oversee maintenance of an up-to-date athlete squad list via Volleyball Australia Athlete Pathways
 Database
- Oversee player management (injury and other incidents)
- Oversee the analysis of team/player data.
- Whilst on tour and attending camps:
 - Construct and manage training schedules and plans
 - Oversee and align JDP Coaches with the VA coaching philosophy and structure.
 - o Responsible for playing group decisions and structure.
 - o Manage the roles and responsibilities of all coaching staff.
 - Manage the roles and responsibilities of all players.
 - o Responsible for match related preparation and training programs.
 - Responsible for match reports and filter published material related to the team/athletes
