Club Houses - all QRA ranges <20 pax	✓	✓	The Health Directions effective 17/12/21 (indoor venues) stipulate a maximum of 20 pax or 1 per 2sqm (whichever is the lesser). Club houses are often a mix of "indoor" and "outdoor" as defined by Queensland Health. This presents a challenge for Clubs to ensure compliance should unvaccinated people be permitted to enter club houses. Clubs or the Venue owner are to determine the appropriate course of action.
Club Houses - all QRA ranges >20pax	✓	✗	
Belmont Shooting Complex - QRA Café	✓	✗	QRA Café is a licensed venue.
QRA Café - Private Function	✓	✓	Maximum of 20 pax. 1 per 2sqm applies.
Firearms Safety Courses - completed by RTO	✓	✓	Maximum of 20 pax. 1 per 2sqm applies.

In all cases QRA recommends providing clear communications to attendees of the decision reached to permit or refuse access to unvaccinated people.

eg: Under the Queensland Public Health and Social Measures linked to vaccination status Direction, Firearms Safety Courses are completed by a RTO and unvaccinated people are permitted to attend.

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Indoor Ranges	✓	✓	Sport in indoor spaces - occupant density limit applies – no more than 1 person per 2 square metres The space to be measured does not include forward of the firing line. No occupant density requirement on the field of play
