VALE: VICKI WARREN, OAM

We note the recent passing of Vicki Warren OAM who, with husband Ian (Ike), was a stalwart of Queensland Masters Hockey for decades. I had the pleasure of touring with Ike to South Africa in 1998 along with Brian Pallister and Doug Dawson from the ACT and to Birmingham in 2007.

I best knew Vicki from Australian Championships where she would invariably be a manager (since 2015) a technical officer (since 2005). She also played in Queensland Women's Masters teams from 1988 on. Many ACT players will have encountered her at events and particularly when we played Queensland.



Vicki was one of the rare people who had a perpetual positivity and good humour that made her impossible not to like. As Technical Officer at the World Cup in Canberra I was impressed to see the way she handled the myriad of teams with apparent ease and aplomb which belied their complexity under the overarching FIH regulations. Ask anyone what the regs are and they will throw up their hands in horror!

At the Mens Masters Invitational 2022 return to hockey Vicki was the Tournament Director. Typically, it was a well-run event where she was rarely seen but the hockey ran as smooth as silk, notwithstanding a number of major "left field" occurrences.

She was also a long serving member of the Queensland and Maryborough Softball Associations.

AUSTRALIAN O/40s CLAIM SILVER AT WORLD CUP

The Australian Masters O/40s Team competed at the recent World Cup, held in Nottingham England. In the Gold Medal match, after being 2-0 down to England, the Aussies managed to force the match to a 2-2 draw and a shootout. The equaliser came from a sensational goal by Vice-Captain Matt Hotchkis, described by UK media as the *'goal of the tournament'*.

Great work team. The result was silver with the Aussie Men being defeated 3-1 in the shootout. What an amazing effort!

ACT's Michael Young umpired the O/35 Bronze Medal match between Argentina and Ireland, in a game he described as the "most challenging and intense game (he) had ever umpired".

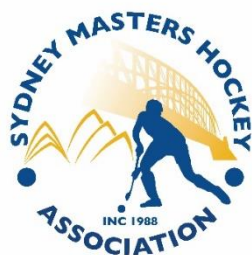

INTERCITY CHALLENGE 2022

The Merv Goodridge & Doug Dawson Cup

Sydney Masters Hockey Association will play host for the Intercity Challenge 2022. All games will be played on 19 & 20 November at Cintra Park (the home ground of Briars Hockey Club) in Concord. This was the 3rd field used for the 2013 Australian Masters Hockey Championships and is 10 minutes from Sydney Olympic Park.



The initial planning is for 2 games per Age Group (4 x 15 minutes quarters each game) commencing at 12.30pm on Saturday 19 November (to enable Canberra players to drive up in the morning).

The Briars Hockey Club will be the hosts and manage the canteen and hospitality for the weekend – this will include a BBQ throughout each day and drinks after each game and at the conclusion (for presentations on the Sunday afternoon).

Age Divisions. Along the same lines as 2021 – 4 teams: 34 to 49's (Masters), 50 to 59's (Senior Masters), 60 to 67's (Grand Masters) and Over 68 (Legends)

Nominations. Nominations will open on the ACT Masters website shortly. Keep a look out for a newsletter and Facebook post with details.

Accommodation. If you are interested in playing, you should make your own accommodation bookings **NOW**. There are a range of options close to Cintra Park/Sydney Olympic Park. Remember the Saturday night function is at Sydney Olympic Park and consider this when booking your accommodation.

Playing Strip. ACT Teams will wear our normal ACT championship strip.

ACT MASTERS HOCKEY SERVICE AWARDS

In 2020 the Committee accepted a recommendation to develop a Service Award to recognise the commitment of members of ACT Masters Hockey, much of which had gone unheralded over the 40 year history of the Association. Up until 2020 the only means of recognising service to the Association was through Life Membership. This meant that a wide range of service by members went without a visible acknowledgement of the time and effort provided for the betterment of Masters hockey in the ACT and across Australia.

The Service Award has four levels of recognition: Bronze, Silver, Gold and Life Membership, with each of the first three levels achieved by way of a points system. Points are awarded to recognise service and achievement for a range of categories, including playing and coordinating teams in our local competitions, representing the ACT as a player, coach, manager and official, and additional service on committees and specialised appointments in service of Masters hockey.

The Committee began presenting the first Awards to recipients in early 2021. Awards have progressively been presented at functions and events throughout the year, including the Canberra Cup, LifeNight, Annual State Dinner (National Championships), the Intercity Challenge and the Xmas 7-a-side Competition.

To date, 71 Bronze, 24 Silver, 29 Gold and 17 Life Member Awards have been approved.

The ACT State Dinner on the Gold Coast will see an opportunity to present a further 19 awards to well deserving members of our Association.

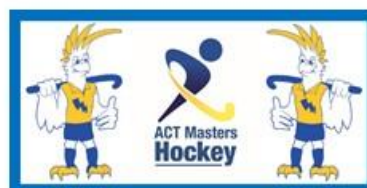
