#### REGISTRATION OF PLAYERS/OFFICIALS/VOLUNTEERS

Registration of players/officials/volunteers through the national **RevSport** process is critical to you as an individual and to the sport in general.

For the individual it means **insurance cover**, regardless of your categorisation. If you are injured and are not registered the prospect of being covered by the WPA national insurance scheme is highly unlikely. This applies to all/any individuals – whether it is a 'Flippa-Ball' event through to playing competition/representing your State. It includes Volunteers who manager teams/take on table duties and the like.

For the sport registration means it can substantiate the numbers when a Club or the Association is lobbying for access/facilities/seeking grants. The numbers matter!

#### COVID VACCINATIONS – INTERSTATE TRAVEL

With the almost daily changing landscape of State border opening/re-openings, State COVID vaccination percentages/rates and State Government policies it may be prudent to be 'fully vaccinated' if you are planning to travel interstate for a waterpolo event and/or championship.

## FEE STRUCTURE CHANGES – WPA/WPSA

WPA has changed the fee structure for the sport nationally. WPSA has also amended its fee structure to align with the national body and to provide a better value for money proposition to participants.

The WPA/WPSA Fee Structure will be as follows:

### WPA Membership Categories

**Platinum Membership - \$66:** People of all ages who wish to be able to participate in any formal competitions and informal events

#### **Benefits:**

- Up to 12 months access to play in formal competitions and informal events (regardless of age)
- COMPLETE access to the **Learning and Development Framework** online materials and face-to-face programs
- Full access to all member benefit programs and discount offers
- Full insurance coverage and provision of all WPA services

**The majority of WPSA Members will fall into this category.**

**Gold Membership - \$40:** Coaches and/or referees who do not wish to also **PLAY** in Formal Competitions. Gold members may play in Informal events at no additional cost

#### **Benefits:**

- Up to 12-month access to play in informal events (regardless of age)
- COMPLETE access to the Learning and Development Framework online material and face to face programs
- Full access to all member benefit programs and discount offers
- Full insurance coverage and provision of all WPA services

**Silver Membership - \$35:** People who play only in informal events and do not coach and/or referee

#### **Benefits:**

- Up to 12-month access for players to informal events (regardless of age)
- COMPLETE access to all member benefit programs and discount offers
- Full insurance coverage and provision of all WPA services
- Access to a limited range of content in the Learning and Development Framework

**Bronze Membership – Complimentary:** Table officials, supporters, parents, volunteers, Flippaball members and players who are only participating in schools only competitions for their school or in a school combined team

#### **Benefits:**

- COMPLETE access to all member benefit programs and discount offers
- Full insurance coverage and provision of all WPA services
- Access to a limited range of content in the Learning and Development Framework

## NATIONAL STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS – JANUARY 2022

The National State Championships are being held in Brisbane in January 2022 on the following dates:

### **10<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> January 2022: 16&U and 18&U National State Championships**

*13<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup> January 2022: WPA Cadet Male and Female Camps (athletes selected from the 16&U NSC)*

*13<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> January 2022: WPA Youth Male and Female Camps (athletes selected from the 18&U NSC)*

### **17<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> January 2022: 20&U National State Championships**

*17<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> January 2022: WPA Youth Male and Female Squads compete in 20&U NSC*

*20<sup>th</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> January 2022: WPA Junior Male and Female Camps (athletes selected from the 20&U NSC)*

The age groups have now been updated to accommodate the shift into 2022, however it is the same athletes who were due to compete in September and December 2021, respectively.

The 16&U (Born 2006 and younger) and 18&U (2004 and younger) National State Championships will be held from January 10 to 13 and be followed by a Cadet and Youth National Age Group Camp.

The 20U (Born 2002 and younger) National State Championships will be held from January 17 to 20. Two National Youth Teams will also participate in the 20U event following their camp.

## Costs

Estimated costs for an individual player is estimated at between \$1,500 and \$1,750 each (WPA Competition Fees, Airfares ex-Adelaide, accommodation and vehicle hire.

This cost does NOT include uniforms – individual purchase – or player food component – normally about \$200-\$250 each.

It is anticipated that you will receive an initial Invoice (\$1,000) and a final Invoice prior to the Competition once final costs are known.

## AYC – APRIL 2022 (BRISBANE)

AYC has now been (re) scheduled to be held back in Brisbane, **Queensland across five days, 14-18 April 2022 (Easter School Holidays)**. Given the compressed nature of the event with all teams competing over 5 days Brisbane provides sufficient access to pools to allow this to happen.

Additional changes will also be that only **three age groups** will be contested at the 2022 AYWPC, with the 12&U age group removed on a one-off basis and that ***athletes and coaches will only be permitted to play/coach in one age group***.

WPSA will be nominating six teams as follows: **14&U Boys and Girls, 16&U Boys and Girls and 18&U Men & Women**.

The 2023 Australian Youth Water Polo Championships will be held in Perth, Western Australia with dates to be confirmed.
